

Statewide Health Information Exchange

The **Kentucky Health Information Exchange (KHIE)**, housed at the Cabinet for Health and Family Services (CHFS), is a secure, interoperable electronic network that supports statewide exchange of patient health information among healthcare providers across the Commonwealth.

KHIE includes a master patient index, record locator service, security, provider/user authentication, logging and audits. The system includes patient demographics, lab results, radiology and other transcribed reports, historical patient diagnoses, encounters, and procedures. KHIE acts as a data intermediary for public health reporting to the state immunization and cancer registries, reporting of syndromic surveillance data and reportable labs/diseases. KHIE also offers a community record (virtual health record) for care coordination.

KHIE Connectivity Options and Available Data

- The patient clinical record is available through the Community Record or Summary of Care Record
 - The Community Record uses an edge server connected via a Virtual Private Network (VPN)
 - The Summary of Care record uses KHIE's Platinum Service which utilizes 'Integrating the Healthcare Enterprise' (ihe) Profiles technology

- KHIE is pleased to announce that we have contracted with Deloitte Consulting, LLP as our new HIE vendor. These are exciting times and we have hit the ground running to ensure a smooth implementation and transition. Some important things for you to know right now:

 - * KHIE supports bidirectional data exchange to submit immunization data and receive immunization forecasts and histories from KYIR.
 - * The Cancer Registry, Reportable Labs, and Syndromic Surveillance continue to onboard through the KHIE connections as well.
 - * KHIE will keep you apprised of progress and provide updates of all important milestones.

- The Kentucky Medicaid EHR Incentive Program has received approval from CMS to allow ALL Eligible Providers (EPs) attesting to Meaningful Use Stage 3, regardless of practice setting, to count Syndromic Surveillance Reporting towards Objective 8 Public Health and Clinical Data Registry Reporting. EPs in an urgent care setting will continue to attest to Measure 2 Syndromic Surveillance Reporting, while EPs in a non-urgent care setting will attest to Measure 4 Public Health Registry Reporting.

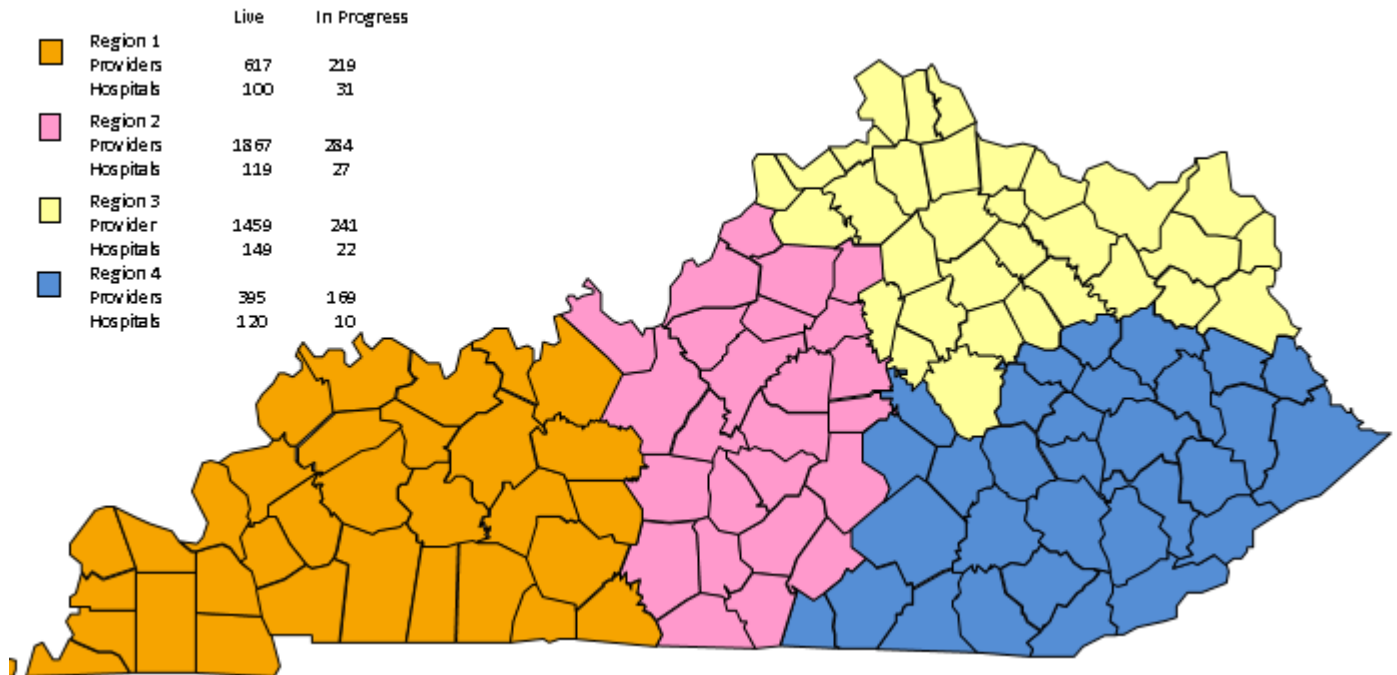
