



The Kentucky Health Information Exchange (KHIE) serves as the data intermediary in Kentucky for healthcare providers seeking to electronically submit patient immunization data to the Kentucky Immunization Registry.

Immunization data submission through KHIE counts toward Measure 1—Immunization Registry Reporting for Meaningful Use Modified Stage 2 and Stage 3.

What KHIE Needs

- ⇒ Signed KHIE Participation Agreement and Immunization Registry Authorization addendum
- ⇒ ONC certified immunization interface
- ⇒ CVX codes representing the substance administered

How it Works

KHIE supports bidirectional data exchange to submit immunization data and receive immunization forecasts and histories from the Kentucky Immunization Registry (KYIR). To receive immunization data from KYIR, providers must be connected to KHIE via a web service connection. Alternatively, providers wanting to view and print patient immunization history can request access to the KYIR portal.
