



EHR Incentive Program participants can utilize the Kentucky Health Information Exchange (KHIE) as a Clinical Data Registry to satisfy the Meaningful Use Stage 3 Public Health and Clinical Data Registry Reporting objective. To count KHIE as a registry reporting measure, the EHR Incentive Program participant must demonstrate Meaningful Use Active Engagement for KHIE's Platinum Service.

What KHIE Needs

- ⇒ Signed KHIE Participation Agreement with Platinum Connection Criteria in Exhibit B elected
- ⇒ Participant must utilize software that is capable of querying KHIE for patient health information using Integrating the Healthcare Enterprise (IHE) XDS.b or XCA standard

How It Works

Your signed KHIE participation agreement with Platinum Connection Criteria in Exhibit B elected demonstrates Meaningful Use Active Engagement Option 1, Completed Registration to Submit Data. During onboarding, KHIE will work with the KHIE participant to test their ability to query KHIE for patient health information from within their health IT software.

There are no certification and standards criteria specified in the Office of the National Coordinator for Health Information Technology (ONC) EHR Technology Certification Criteria corresponding to this particular objective.
